Sir,

With reference to your application dated 3-6-1981 on the aforesaid subject, the undersigned grants composite recognition from class I to VIII (without aid) to your school w.e.f. next academic session i.e. 1982-83, with the following terms and conditions:-

That the school will admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.

That the school will abide by the rules and regulations of the Delhi School Education Act and Rules, 1973, and instructions issued there under from time to time.

That the qualified staff will be appointed as per present norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi.

That the head of school is appointed/promoted as per norms and recruitment rules prescribed by the Deptt.

That the management of the school will spend Rs. 3000/- for strengthening the school laboratory.

That the management of the school will spend 5000/- for strengthening the existing school library and dining room facilities as provided to the statements, as well as to the teachers.

That the fees will not be charged without the permission of the Director of Education, Dashmesh Public School, no development fee will be charged from the students.

That the school will follow the syllabus/books prescribed by the department.

That no employee of the school shall be dismissed or reduced in rank nor shall his/her services otherwise terminated without the prior permission of the Director of Education, Delhi.

That the management of the school will pay the salary to the staff through crossed cheques.

That the various scales of pay, allowances, medical facilities, pension etc. etc.

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Prescribed benefits of the employees should be same as admissible to Govt. employees of Corresponding States.

12. That all the recognised classes from class I to VIII shall be held in one bldg. and no unrecognised classes be held in that bldg.
13. That on undertaking to this effect that no school or branch in the name of this school is running in any other locality, may be submitted within a month of the enforcement of this letter.
14. That the management of the school will furnish information to the Directorate of Education, Delhi vide rule 130 of Delhi School Education Act, 1973.
15. That the school will not run for the profit of any individual group or association of individual or any other person.
16. That the school will be open to officers of the Directorate of Education, Delhi for inspection and guidance.
17. All facilities under rules 50 and 51 shall be made available in the institution.
18. That the necessary adequate accommodation and furniture will be made available to all classes. The number of sections in the school should not exceed the class rooms of appropriate size (24'x20').
19. That the managing Committee will take immediate steps for the construction of the school building after obtaining the land from D.D.A.

D.S.E. That the managing Committee will also make necessary arrangements and other Co-Circular activities as per provisions of the D.S.E. Rules 1973.

20. That the service contract between the management and the employees should be executed immediately and compliance reports be submitted to the Directorate of Education, Delhi within a month of the enforcement of this letter.

Sanitary That the arrangements for good drinking water and sanitation facilities should be made to the students.

21. That the building of the school will not be used for commercial/political or for any other non educational purpose.

Branch That the scheme of management may be got approved within a month from the Act Branch if the s.

12. The Managing Committee of the school shall not increase enhance fee during the ensuing academic session without the prior approval of Director of Education which is a mandatory requirement under sub-section (3) of Section 17 of Delhi School Education Act, 1973.
13. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule 50 & 51 of the DSEB, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
14. XIth Class should not be added without the prior approval of the Director of Education.
15. That the management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs. 40,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only).
16. That the school shall comply with the norms of the CBSE for affiliation fee/examination purposes.
17. That report about the fulfilment of the above conditions shall be sent to the Education Officer every six month.

That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 and Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.

That the school shall meet the additional liability of Senior Secondary classes.

That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.

That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student shall be purchased and made available to the students.

That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students.

That all the fees charged under Rules Principal 51 of DASHMESH PUBLIC SCHOOL D.S.E.R.-1973 shall be payable to DASHMESH PUBLIC SCHOOL Vasundhra Enclave, Delhi-110096.

Proper facilities for drinking water, toilets and first aid be provided. Separate toilets for boys, girls and separate toilets for ladies and gents staff be also provided.

That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Section 10(1) of the D.S.E.A.-1973.

That the school shall not run any un-recognised classes or any non-educational activities within the school premises.

Fresh health certificate from M.C.D. be obtained and given to the Education Officer for verification.

That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and overaged staff, if any, immediately.

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13. That adequate and sufficient accommodation of 10 sq.ft. per student shall be provided for the class room. The minimum size of the class room should not be less than 300 sq.ft. (20' x 15') atleast to accommodate 30 students per class/section. The rooms should be properly cross ventilated. The rooms should not be clased from three sides.
14. The Managing Committee of the school shall not increase/ enhance fee during the ensuing academic session without the prior approval of the Director of Education which is a mandatory requirement under sub-section (3) of Section 17 of D.S.E.A. 1973.
15. That the Management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund equal to minimum three months salary of the staff in the joint name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the school.
16. That the school shall comply with the norms of the C.B.S.E. for affiliation fee/examination purposes.
17. That report about the fulfilment of the above conditions shall be sent to the Education Officer within six months.
